Symptoms of a head or brain injury may not show immediately, they can range from concussions to traumatic brain injuries.



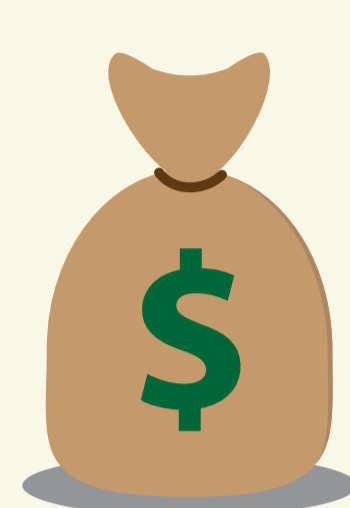
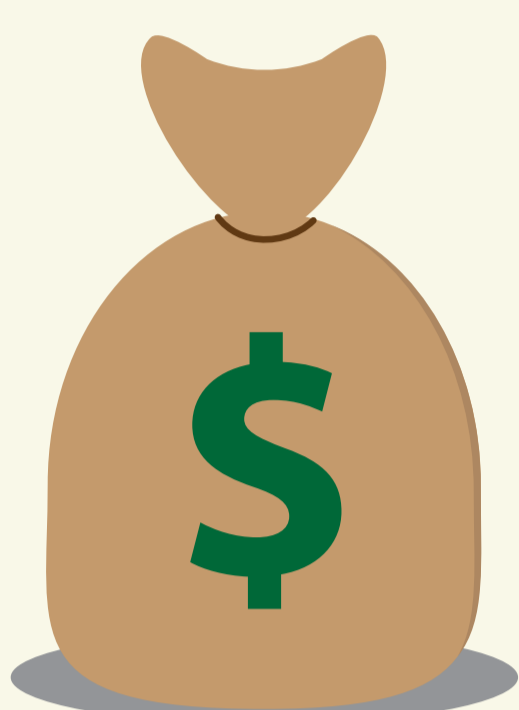
The Cost of Traumatic Brain Injuries

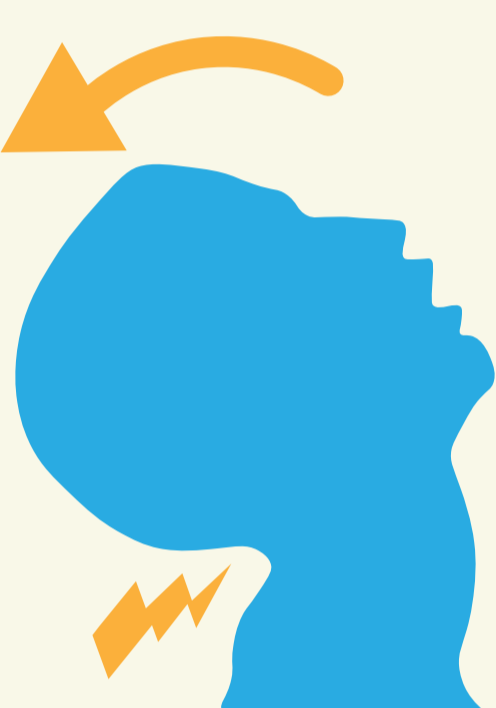

Neck Injuries

Injuries to the face are common from airbags, steering wheels, glass, and more.

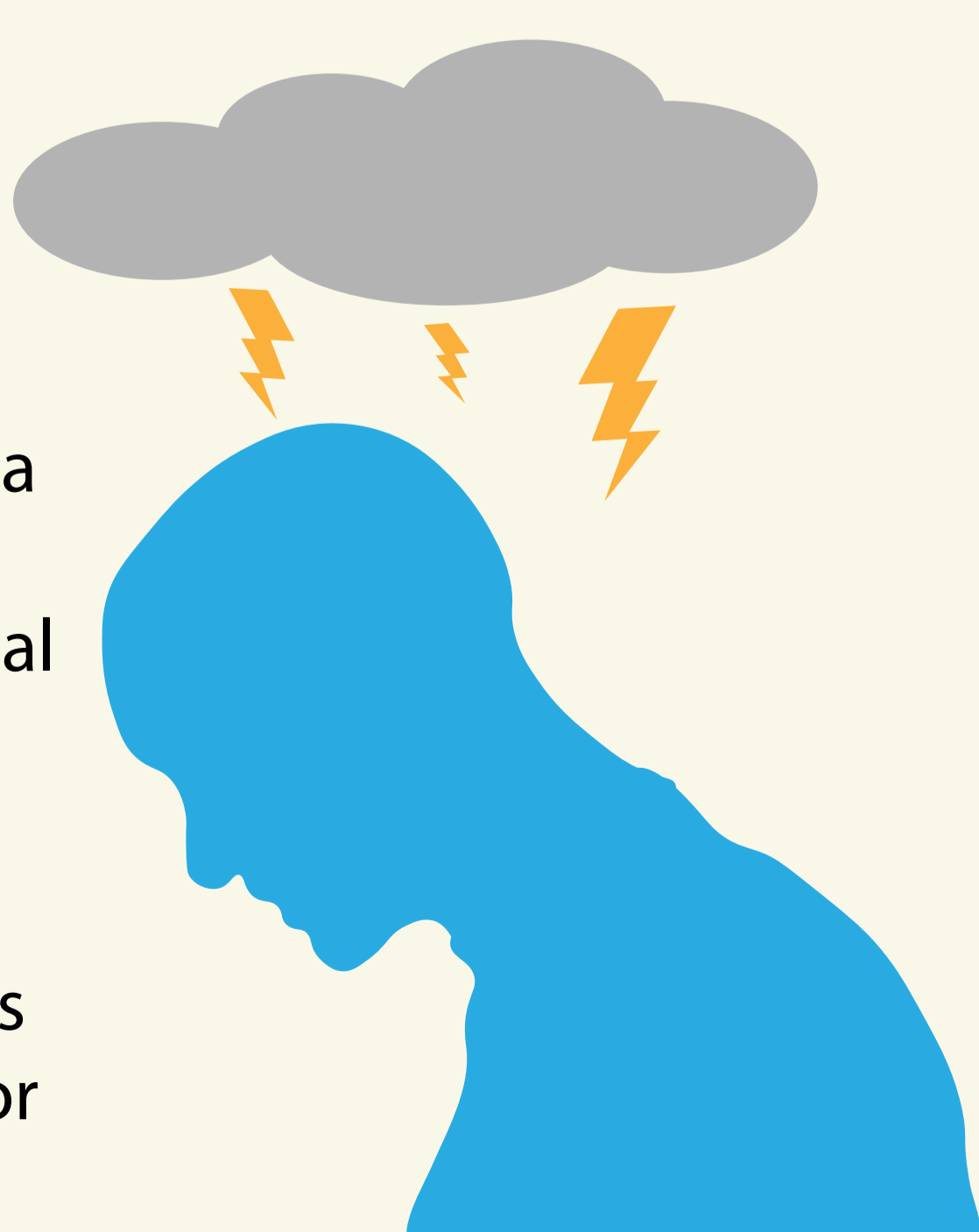
More serious problems like fractures and dental injuries can also occur.
